*You must plant at least 10 feet away from fire hydrants, driveways or utility poles. Only Class 1 trees may be planted under power lines.

Cottonwoods, Poplars, Aspen, Silver Maple, Willows, Birch, Russian Olive, & Conifers (No fruiting trees or multi-stem trees)
