

SEED POTATOES

PREP

Cut seed potatoes into pieces 1-1.25" with a couple eyes per piece

LOCATION

Full sun, well-drained soil, good to change location yearly.

WHEN

Early-Mid May when the soil has warmed up to at least 50 degrees F



SPACING

Dig a trench 6" deep, plant 8-12" apart

HARVESTING

Little spuds can be dug after 70 days; mature ones after fall frost



Tips and Tricks:

Don't plant in areas where tomatoes, peppers, eggplants, radishes, or beets were grown previously. Do not amend your soil with lime or manure in the same year that potatoes are to be grown, as they both increase the risk of scab.
